# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

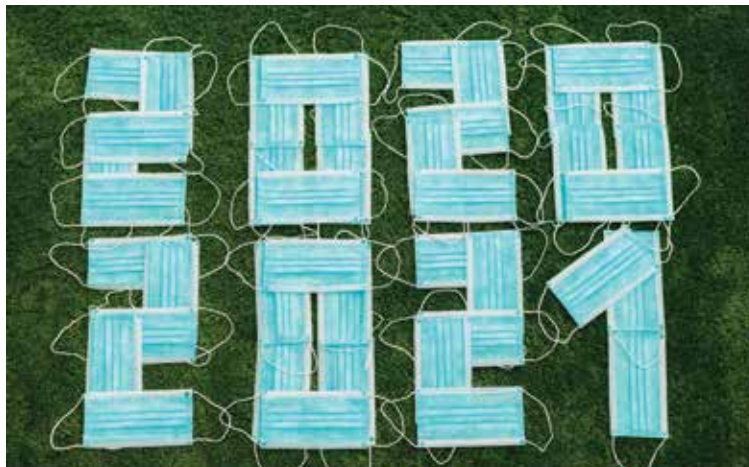

A friend related that same night that his travel home from Thousand Oaks to

Moorpark was delayed. The Sheriff had closed the freeway off ramps near the Thousand Oaks Mall. I was proud to know our police were not standing down! So I watched on Zoom the next Camarillo City Council meeting. There I heard it was time to change our police response to some calls, and that an endorsement of BLM was to be presented for a vote at the next month's meeting.

CRWF members began a letter writing campaign to all members of the City Council in response to this challenge. Our club then initiated a "Support the Police" rally at City Hall. This event took off and we had an enormous response both by the attendees and the cars passing by. We went on to participate in rallies for President Trump in Santa Monica and to create an event in Oxnard in support of President Trump. The car rally in Camarillo and the boat parade, etc., are some of the events in which we participated. Support for Joe Biden was invisible.

Conservative voices are realizing that politics at the local, state and national level are our responsibility. The future of our children and grandchildren are at stake. We must stay vigilant and find ways to engage our talents. I rarely watch the news as it paints a distorted view and diminishes hope. There are other ways to learn about the news. ## CALL TO ACTION FOR ALL CFRW WOMEN:

At the recent California Federation of Republican Women (CFRW) Biennial Convention in October 2021, the CFRW joined with the National Federation of Republican Women (NFRW) and the Republican National Committee (RNC) in passing several resolutions that focus on very important issues for both the State and National level. The key issues are:

- Water Infrastructure
- “Keep 9” effort to stop the packing of the Supreme Court
- CRT in our Schools

The CFRW will be addressing these issues over the next several weeks.

The first Resolution the CFRW is highlighting is “Keep 9” Resolution:

At the Biennial CFRW Convention, CFRW President Sue Blair signed, passed by vote of membership, in support of the “Keep Nine Amendment”.....to keep nine Justices on the Supreme Court. The U.S. Supreme Court has been composed of nine Justices for more than 150 years, joining NFRW and the RNC in supporting Constitutional Amendment 9, in direct response to the blatant power grab by the Democrats in the House and by the Senate, who have introduced a plethora of bills to amend the 9th Constitutional Amendment. The Resolution states that the United States President and Congress should be prohibited from undermining the independence of the Supreme Court by attempting to

change the number of Justices on the Court. The Call to Action for CFRW Members is:

1. Educate every CFRW Member that without an Amendment to pack the Court, the pro-Court packing left will certainly pack the Court.
2. Make the “Keep Nine” Amendment to ban Court Packing a household phrase among voters.
3. Get every Republican who wants to stop the Washington left from seizing absolute power to join the CFRW, NFRW, RNC, former Reagan Attorney General Ed Meese, and more than 1,000 Republican elected officials around the nation in endorsing the “Keep Nine” Amendment.

4. Build a “5 minute a month or more” network of CFRW volunteers who will call elected officials, communicate on social media, and encourage groups they work with to endorse and publicize the Keep Nine Amendment.

The Mission of the Keep Nine Coalition is to preserve an Independent Supreme Court so that the next generation will not need to ask: “How did America lose an independent Supreme Court. Why did they not protect it when they had the chance?,” (Roman Buhler).

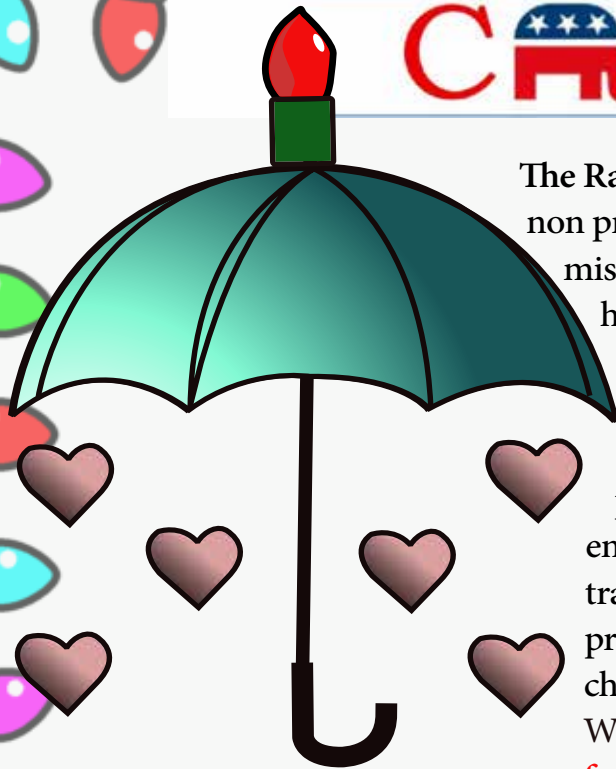

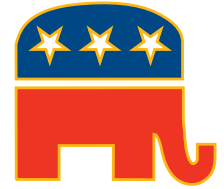
