APRIL 2022 ACTION ALERT AND UPDATES

Action Alert: "The Educational Freedom Act" Petition Deadline is early April 2022

Every child deserves a choice of the school they attend, the education they receive. More than two years in the drafting, the Educational Freedom Act treats everyone in California equally.

Parents of every California child have the freedom to spend \$14,000 provided by the State of California at a school of their choice-no matter how much money they make. The Educational Freedom Act gets it right. It makes everything equal and fair. The key is the direction of state education tax dollars into hands of parents. That funding follows the student without conditions, mandates, or means testing. Every California family and every California student is treated

equally. Go to: https://www.californiaschoolchoice.org/ Scroll down on "Click to Print and Sign". The petition can be printed either back-to-back or as single pages. Once printed, all 6 pages of the document must be submitted in numerical order.

AB-1594 Firearms: Civil Lawsuits: Existing law defines public nuisance and provides that a public nuisance may be remedied by an indictment or a civil action, or abatement. Existing law also

regulates the manufacture, sale or marketing of firearms. AB-194 would specify that a gun industry member has created or maintained a public nuisance, if their failure to follow federal, state, or local law caused injury or death or death if the gun industry member engaged in unfair business practices. (CA Attorney General Rob Bonta and Phil Ting CA Assembly D)

AB-2571 Existing law generally regulates manufacturers and dealers of firearms. Under existing law, commercial speech or advertising is generally protected under the First Amendment. Existing laws and regulations however, restrict the content and placement of advertising and promotional marketing of alcohol, cannabis, and tobacco to protect minors. This bill would add limiting the marketing of certain firearms to children. (Rebecca Bauer-Kahan CA Assembly D)



CALIFORNIA HAS LOWEST LITERACY RATE OF ANY STATE

Article 26.3 of the United Nations' Universal Declaration of Human Rights states: "Parents have a prior right to choose the kind of education that shall be given to their children." "masturbation, homosexuality, gender fluidity, homosexual parenting, graphic images of genitalia, and more."

During elementary school, children are exposed to pornographic, including "cartoons" in books such as "It's Perfectly Normal," featuring cartoon images of naked children, sexual intercourse, children masturbating, and more. The book is available to middle school children and promoted by Planned Parenthood.

For "7th graders, to outline the risks of various sex acts, for example, children ages 11 and 12 are taught that 'anal sex using a condom correctly is a 'low-risk' activity. However, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) found that condoms are only 60% to 70% effective in preventing HIV, even with perfect and consistent use."

The Democrats are pushing "these are not your children. They are wards of the state." The teachers' unions that fund the Democrat party will determine what and how they learn.



When the children are around 11, under 3Rs, they're taught how to seek out information about sex on the internet, and to rely on Planned Parenthood for information and "services." When they are age 12, "abortion is introduced as an 'option' to deal with unwanted pregnancies. And by age 13 years, the children are taught how to obtain various forms of contraception and birth control."

Local property taxpayers pay the teachers wages, yet teachers feel the taxpayers have no say in what is taught to their kids.

Parents are finding out about the global campaign that the UN, Planned Parenthood, the ACLU, and others are using sex and your children to eliminate the nuclear family. First, they worked to get Mom out of the home into a "career," so they could go after the children.

In California, "nearly 1 in 4 people over the age of 15 lack the skills to decipher the words in this sentence. Only 77 percent of adults are considered mid to highly literate, according to the nonpartisan data crunchers at World Population Review."

"Recent research shows that even high-performing California students score lower on standard tests than their counterparts in better performing States." (Will Schuck, Capitol Weekly 2/28/22) School libraries are filled with storybooks pushing radical transgender ideology, lessons on masturbation for middle schoolers, and novels with explicit sexual scenes including one describing a bloody rape.

In California, Brea Olinda Unified School District included ancient Greek men's proclivity to have sexual relations with boys, as part of teaching children LGBT history. A mom asked about the course and sounded incredulous, "So sex between a man and a boy is a sexual orientation" she asked.
