#### HIGHLIGHTS FROM OUR NOVEMBER 2022 KEYNOTE SPEAKER PEGGY HALL

At our November 2022 General Meeting/Luncheon attendees had the opportunity to hear from Peggy Hall ...Founder of THE HEALTHY AMERICAN and a national leader in the freedom movement (particularly in regards to our health and well-being) and is dedicated to "breathing life back into liberty". In describing herself Peggy noted "I am probably a lot like you. A curious person who wants to dig deeper to understand what is happening to my country, my life and my freedom. I want to live life healthy and free." Her mission is to educate, inform and inspire others to do the same.

Peggy is the former Director of Teacher Education at the University of California, Irvine, and has been an educator for 30 plus years. In addition to her experience as an educator, Peggy is also an accomplished health writer, with hundreds of articles published in major magazines over the past 20 years. She also served as the national wellness expert for the ABC Radio Network, with over 500 radio appearances as the national wellness expert for the Emmy-nominated show, America Now. And with the founding of The Healthy

The Healthy American was founded in May 2020, as the medical research about the COVID-19 Pandemic continued to result in more questions about the validity of the COVID-19 Pandemic, yet the health mandates increased and America was shutting down. Peggy questioned the mask mandates, especially for children, the need to shut down entire businesses, and the need to require citizens to stop living/participating in their communities and instead isolate at home 24/7.

Her Mission is to educate and inspire others to take positive action(s) to defend our God-given rights as protected by the Constitution. To fight tyranny by promoting and defending truth and freedom for all. The Healthy American is Peggy's platform to share the research and links she has uncovered, all with the goal to educate, inform and inspire us to take action to promote truth and freedom, through her educational videos, hours of legal research, and online and in-person programs to keep businesses open, to help parents get their children out of government schools, and to help Americans protect their medical rights.

Her objective is to empower patriots all across the United States to take action to start "positive waves of change" to



America, Peggy has established herself as a dedicated and recognized community activist. She has a bachelor's degree in Political Science, a Master's Degree in International Relations.

In her position(s) as a cutting edge educator and published health care writer, Peggy relied on her honed research skills to provide the most current and accurate information to her students, and to teach them to develop research skill sets that will serve them to think critically. Peggy explained that her experience of working for the government first hand showed her how to not believe what she was told, until she could see it with her own eyes, or to verify it through other credible sources. And she encouraged all of the caring, thinking citizens to do the same. She is steadfast in her belief that knowledge is power. She cautioned the audience to the fact that news does not exist to provide unbiased information.... news is primarily focused on fear, not on giving the listeners the solution.

fight back the growing tidal wave of tyranny in our country. In closing, Peggy urged the audience to "not trust your health to the headlines. Do not trust your life to the media, and do not trust your well-being to the government".
